#### Important Notes:-

1. Any No. of skaters allowed to register in each Age Group in Quad and Inline races from each District in both Boys and Girls.
2. Cadet skaters (Quad and Inline) of the age group 5 - 7 years Boys & girls can take part in 2 out of the 3 races,
3. Quad and Inline skater of Age Group 07 - 09, 09 - 11, 11-14, 14-17 & Above 17 yers can take part in maximum 3 out of the 4 races.
4. Inline skaters are not allowed to take part in Quads races similarly Quad skaters are not allowed to take part in Inline Races.
5. Speed Technical Committee General Regulations and Updated World Skate(FIRS) Speed Skating rules Shall be followed for conducting all races .
6. For other details please refer to General Rules for Speed Skating 2022.

Entry Fees: Rs. 700/- Venue: Zone - I Tirupathi, Zone - II Kakinada, Zone - III Visakhapatnam:

Zone - I: Only skaters from Prakasam, Nellore, Chittoor, Kadapa, Anantapur, and Kurnool are permitted.

Zone - II: Only skaters from East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, and Guntur are permitted.

Zone - III: Only skaters from Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, and Visakhapatnam are permitted.

1. The tournament will be held as per RSFI rules and regulations and will be conducted by RSFI qualified technical officials from APRSA.

2. The track/road is available for practice only one day before the start of the championship.
3. Entry: The 1st Zonal Ranking Championships (Speed Skating) entry is to be done online. Please go to the website of APRSA - [www.rollersportsap.org](http://www.rollersportsap.org). Register and log in with the password. Fill in the entry carefully, scan the photo & e-Aadhaar/Aadhaar upload. After completing & uploading all the entries online, take a printout of the entries. One copy of the hard copy of the entry is to be submitted to the Championship Committee office. Registration opens on 22nd May & closes on 31st May 2024.
4. Claims: As per RSFI rules, the claim fee of Rs. 2,000/- shall be enclosed along with every written application for the claim made to the Chief Referee. The claim must be made by the skater/manager within 15 minutes before or after the completion of the event. Depending on the availability of time and concerned records, the Speed Technical Committee of RSFI will decide the matter. In case the claim is upheld, the fee will be returned. No claim shall be entertained from the coaches/parents. Claims shall be accepted only from the concerned team manager(s) whose name appears in the entry form furnished by the State/UT association(s). On appeal, the verdict/decision of the Jury of Appeal, at any level, shall be final and binding on one and all.
5. Race: Races/competitions with less than 3 participants will not be conducted, and the entry fee will be forfeited.
6. Liability: Please note that for any injury/losses caused to the participants during the above tournament, on or off the skating/playing area, OC/ shall not be responsible and/or liable to meet any expenses/damages whatsoever. Therefore, all participating skaters are to take adequate accidental, medical, and life insurance policies. They are to carry the necessary policies with themselves.
7. Uniform/Equipment: Skaters have to come in proper uniform and with proper equipment for the speed events. Helmets (headgear) are compulsory.
8. In case any unforeseen circumstances prevent the completion of the schedule of events, the decision by the RSFI/APRSA observer will be final.
9. Anti-Doping Rules: The Anti-Doping Rules of the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) apply to all participants. The players can be medically examined by the concerned agencies or any other agency advised by the government RSAG/RSFI/WS/WSA at any point in time. The RSAG/RSFI may ask for necessary medical certificates in this regard from any player at any point in time. Expenses, if any, in this regard, are to be borne by the concerned skater(s).
